Both Kinds of Music on CKUW 95.9 FM

The TwangTrust started life as an "alt.country" show, but there's not much that matters that you won't hear on this Wednesday evening institution. It's a country music show, as long as you're willing to accept that Hank Williams got his start at CBGB's and the Grand Ol' Opry is somewhere off of Route 9 on the Jersey Turnpike.

We could just play 2 hours of great roots-rockin' tracks one after the other, and if you tune in casually you might think that's what we do. But if you pay close attention, you're gonna learn something. About the music - its history, its fables, its place in the world right now. About the musicians - the legends, the cult heroes and the unjustly obscure. About your local scene - what's going on and where you need to be.

What will you hear on the TwangTrust? Our regulars include the likes of Steve Earle (our namesake), Bruce Springsteen (and most anyone who covers him), Johnny Cash, Roger Miller, every conceivable permutation of Winnipeg's great Hatcher brothers (The Fuse, The Six, The Big Beat & The Blue Shadows). Plus high & lonesome troubadors, R&B giants, Tex-Mex, blues & grass.
