Bookmark our site to stay on top of the latest music on our charts, program highlights and archives. Upcoming special events are usually posted to the main page, but you can also find out information about the 'Friends of CKUW' program, station history and more. One new feature is the ability to 'subscribe' to our page through a system known as RSS which will keep you posted with updates on our site, RSS subscriptions are usually handled with email programs or news reading software. In addition to station updates, many of our hosts have created individual websites featuring playlists, concert announcements and more. These are usually linked through the online 'Program Guide' by clicking on the show name.

## live streaming

You can stream CKUW live 24/7 anywhere in the world. From our homepage click on the 'Listen Online' link and follow the instructions there. Alternatively you can type out:

<http://206.45.64.144:8000/listen.pls> to get the live stream. Most computers should play back the stream automatically but if you need additional software programs like Winamp, Realplayer and VLC will do the trick.

## archives

Miss your favourite show? Can't be by the radio all the time? Got Internet? You'll love the CKUW archive and podcast system. Six weeks of program archives and podcasts are available through the program grid on the website ( <http://ckuw.ca/index.php/schedule>).

Click on the 'Audio' button and download or stream any recent episode of any local show on CKUW. If you're podcast savvy you can even set up your software to download your favourite shows whenever a new episode is available.
